HIGHLIGHT OF THE WEEK

The Moot Court

On Friday, participants take on the role of legal counsel and argue their case before a simulated tribunal. Each team is assigned a dedicated DaWo lawyer who mentors them from case assignment to final submission.

01

Case Assignment

On Thursday, teams receive a realistic commercial dispute prepared by DaWo lawyers.

02

Assigned Counsel

Each team is paired with a DaWo lawyer who acts as their personal mentor and coach.

03

Case Preparation

Teams gather evidence, develop their legal arguments and rehearse their oral submissions.

04

Courtroom Hearing

On Friday afternoon, each team presents and defends its case before the tribunal.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit your motivation letter and CV — places are strictly limited to 6–10 participants

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **Motivation letter** (max. 1 page) — why you wish to participate and what you hope to gain from the experience
- **Curriculum vitae** or a brief summary of your current academic background and activities
- **Nationality** and the languages you speak
- **Age** and your current year of study
- **University or school of interest**, which institution(s) you are considering for your legal studies

IDEAL CANDIDATE

- **Age 16–19**, with a genuine interest in law, business or international affairs
- **Intellectually curious**, collaborative and open to working in a diverse, international team
- **Strong command of English** (the working language of the programme throughout the week)
- **No prior legal knowledge required** — drive, curiosity and professionalism are what matter most
